Public Artwork Enhances the Park

The SS&TP Program Office, in partnership with the City of Albuquerque's Public Art Urban Enhancement Division, has planned for a mural to be painted on the south-facing wall of the Cooperative Education Services building in the SS&TP. Amanda Phingbodhipakkiya, an award-winning neuroscientist-turned-multidisciplinary artist and STEM advocate, is scheduled to begin the project in October. Students from Technology Leadership High School, also located in the Park, will help paint the mural. The artwork's theme, "Women in STEM," is in harmony with its surroundings in the Park. The mural is funded by the Heising-Simons Foundation with support from the City's 1% for Public Art Program.



NMSBVI Wins Top Workplace

New Mexico School for the Blind and Visually Impaired (NMSBVI) is one of 52 companies and organizations recognized by the Albuquerque Journal as a "New Mexico Top Workplace" for 2021.
