IDEAS-TEK Receives Flying 40 Award

IDEAS Engineering & Technology (IDEAS-TEK) was one of New Mexico's fastest-growing technology companies of 2022 honored at the 25th annual Flying 40 awards ceremony. IDEAS-TEK employs 16 people and had revenues of \$2.5 million in 2021. The company was recognized as one of the top 5 companies in the under \$10 million category with the highest revenue growth over a four-year period, 2017-2021. The Sandia Science & Technology Park Development Corporation organized and hosted the event which took place at the Albuquerque BioPark/Zoo. Event support also came from many program and community sponsors.




BlueHalo Receives \$16M IRB and \$2.5M LEDA

BlueHalo received approximately \$16 million in industrial revenue bonds (IRB) and \$2.5 million in Local Economic Development Act incentives (LEDA) from the State of New Mexico and City of Albuquerque. The company's goal is to create 64 new jobs with an average salary of about \$90,000. The IRB and LEDA money will help fund the renovation of BlueHalo's new building in the SS&TP. BlueHalo is a provider of advanced engineering solutions and technology to the national security community. The company provides novel capabilities in the domains of Space Superiority and Directed Energy, Missile Defense and C4ISR, and Cyber and Intelligence.

Lisa Abeyta, the new City of Albuquerque Economic Development Department Deputy Director and Elisha Saavedra, PNM Business Development Manager joined the SS&TP Community Advisory Council (CAC).
