Colonel Jonathan Graham, Commander of the 58th Special Operations Wing (SOW) at Kirtland Air Force Base (KAFB), gave an update on current missions at KAFB to members of the business community, cabinet members of the State of New Mexico, and officials from Sandoval and Bernalillo Counties, the City of Albuquerque, and KAFB at the Kirtland Partnership Committee (KPC) annual meeting held at PNM. The SOW employs over 2,500 personnel and trains over 14,000 airman a year in 67 assigned aircraft to respond to worldwide contingencies and provide search and rescue support to the local community. KPC, located in the SS&TP, is a nonprofit organization comprising civic leaders. Their mission is to preserve, support, and grow KAFB. The meeting was sponsored by PNM, a partner and landowner in the SS&TP, and Wells Fargo.
