BioFlyte Raises \$5.4M Investment

Cottonwood Technology Fund and Scout Ventures invested \$5.4 million in BioFlyte to expand the reach of its biosecurity products. Those products are designed to keep different locations safe from harmful toxins, viruses, and bacteria. With this investment, BioFlyte hopes to add four to five positions by the end of the year.
