NMDVR Opens Office

New Mexico Division of Vocational Rehabilitation opened an office in the SS&TP. NMDVR is a division of the state's Public Education Department, a State and Federally funded program. The purpose of NMDVR is to help people with disabilities achieve a suitable employment outcome and partner with companies and agencies seeking opportunities to enhance and diversify their workforce. Once fully staffed, NMDVR will have 34 employees in its Park office.



KPC Meeting Presents KAFB FY2022 Economic Impact

Lieutenant Colonel Matthew Daniels, 377th Air Base Wing Comptroller Squadron Commander, Kirtland Air Force Base (KAFB), presented the FY2022 KAFB Economic Impact Statement at the Kirtland Partnership Committee (KPC) Annual Meeting in December 2023. The report provides information about the economic impact of KAFB on the surrounding community. The total value of KAFB's annual economic impact is \$7.5 billion, of which the local impact of KAFB is \$4.8 billion. KPC, located in the SS&TP, is a nonprofit organization comprising civic leaders created to preserve, support, and grow KAFB.



MITRE Expands Facilities

MITRE Corporation expanded its footprint in the SS&TP by 2,780 square feet for additional office space, putting its total footprint at 6,069 square feet. MITRE, headquartered in McLean, Virginia, is a not-for-profit IT and engineering firm established to advance national security in new ways and serve the public interest as an independent adviser.
