New Report Shows the SS&TP's Economic Contributions

The SS&TP recently released its latest economic impact analysis which is conducted every two years by the Mid-Region Council of Governments at the request of the city of Albuquerque. This independent study highlights the Park's significant economic contributions to the local community, surrounding counties, and the state of New Mexico.

Since the SS&TP's inception in 1998, it has played a vital role in strengthening New Mexico's economy. During this time, companies and organizations within the SS&TP have paid \$8.6 billion in wages and salaries, created more than 6,500 jobs, and contributed \$4.9 billion in taxable consumer spending.

The SS&TP fosters high-wage, private-sector job creation through strong partnerships among Park companies and organizations, Sandia, the Air Force Research Laboratory, and the U.S. Space Force. These collaborations generate substantial state and local tax revenues as well as salaries that exceed the average in the Albuquerque metropolitan area.
