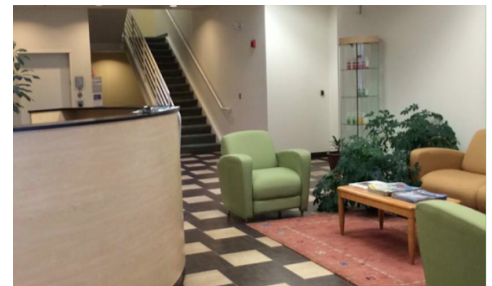
SS&TP CEO Todd Bisio is On the Move
