

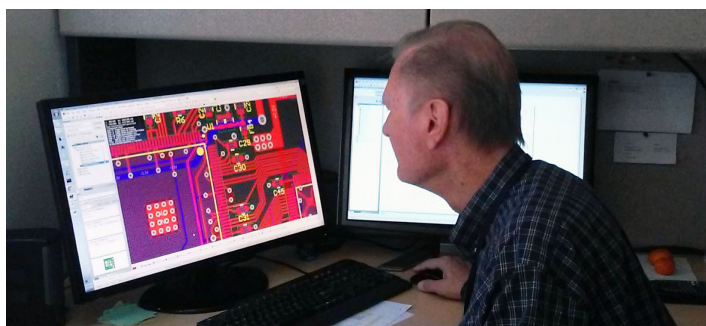

Knowledge Systems, a Sandia affiliated organization, architects and implements innovative, high impact solutions in the field of informatics.

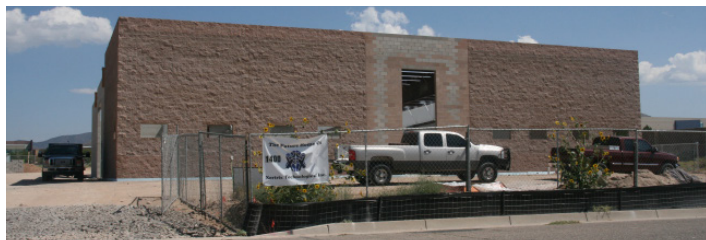
New Mexico Angels focuses on investing in early-stage technology companies to provide opportunities where members can obtain outstanding financial returns.
