NMA Ventures to Invest \$4.2M in Tech Startups

NMA Ventures, located in the SS&TP, will receive \$1.6 million from the Catalyst Fund, and matched it with \$2.6 million of private investor funds to invest in New Mexico startups. The Catalyst Fund invests in emerging venture capital funds throughout the state. NMA will seek out promising high-tech innovation, especially from the state's national laboratories and research universities. NMA Ventures funds early-stage, high-technology companies based in New Mexico.
