The Sandia Science & Technology Park (SS&TP) is delighted to share some highlights from the past year and wish you an innovative, prosperous, and joyful year in 2021!

ECONOMIC IMPACT RESULTS

The **SS&TP** announced the results of a biennial economic impact analysis that was completed by the Mid-Region Council of Governments. The Park companies paid out \$6.4B in wages and salaries, generated \$3.1B worth of economic activity, and produced \$147.4M in tax revenue for the State of New Mexico and \$32M for the City of Albuquerque since the SS&TP was established in 1998.



NEW COMPANIES IN 2020



BioFlyte commercializes a fieldable mass spectrometer that enables miniaturized, low-cost and low-power detection and identification of airborne microbes and toxins in real-time. They have 6 employees in their SS&TP office.



Cybermedia Technologies provides technology, cyber security, and government contract support services; infrastructure computing; mission computing; enterprise IT and information; cloud integration; data management; and healthcare IT consulting. They have 3 employees in their SS&TP office.



IDEAS Engineering & Technology provides digital microelectronics, high-performance and high-reliability embedded systems, and computing and sensing systems to government and commercial customers. They have 15 employees in their SS&TP facility.



TekSynap is a growing small business providing Information Technology to meet the business needs of their customers. They have 3 employees in their SS&TP office.

COMPANY EXPANSIONS IN 2020

BlueHalo, formerly AEgis Technologies (AEgis) and Applied Technology Associates (ATA), now has a total of 49,695 square feet of space due to their merger. Earlier in the year, AEgis expanded to 8,695 square feet from their previous 2,500-square-foot office/lab space. ATA has a 41,000-square-foot building. BlueHalo provides capabilities in Space Superiority, Directed Energy, Missile Defense and C4ISR, and Cyber and Intelligence mission solutions. They have 107 employees in their three SS&TP facilities.

Excelligent expanded to 7,500 square feet from their previous 2,500-square-foot office space. The company is a project management and control consulting firm that is knowledgeable in systems engineering and production processes. They have 9 employees in their SS&TP office.

PARK COMPANIES RESPOND TO COVID-19

One of the New Mexico companies **NMA Ventures** invested in, EveryDay Contacts, a contact lens company, is creating hand sanitizer and has donated over 350 gallons to homeless shelters to date.

PADT is using their 3D printing and engineering capacity to help create Personal Protective Equipment (PPE) for medical workers.



Sandia Laboratory Federal Credit Union quickly adapted and found ways to help keep clients afloat like offering payment relief, loan deferment, and personal relief loans for members.

Xertrix Technologies rapidly produced 100 tubes that Sandia National Laboratories requested for pathogen management kits that can be attached to respiratory machines so they can be safely used as ventilators.
