CTEC Opens Office

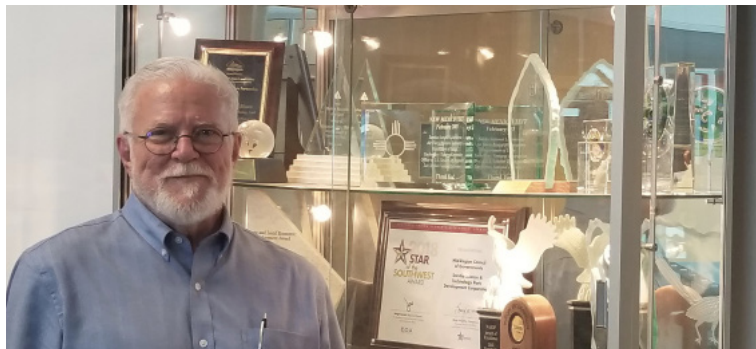
