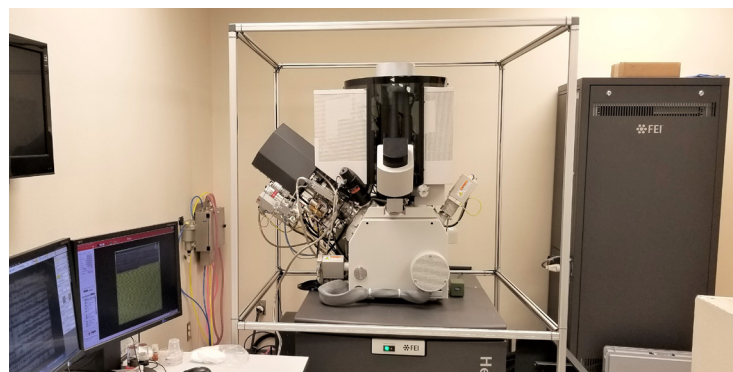
Excelligent Moves into the SS&TP

MSI Adds System for Semiconductor Reverse Engineering

MicroNet Solutions, Inc. (MSI), a company located in the SS&TP, has added the Helios G4 plasma FIB system. It is a fully digital, extreme high resolution field emission scanning electron microscope equipped with an inductively coupled plasma focused ion beam. It allows for in-situ large area sample preparation and high resolution imaging and analysis of hundreds of micron sized areas. This unique new dual beam tool is now available for use by Sandia National Laboratories, SS&TP companies, and other customers.



Raytheon to Merge with United Technologies

Raytheon announced plans to merge with United Technologies Corporation. The combined company will be called Raytheon Technologies Corporation. This merger will create a leading aerospace and defense systems supplier with a diversified technologies portfolio able to meet growing demand from their global customer base. The combined company is expected to be the world's preeminent aerospace and defense systems supplier, ranking in the top 50 of the Fortune 500, with annual revenues of approximately \$74 billion and over 180,000 employees. This merger will also enhance the growth of the SS&TP site.
