ATA Aerospace Instrumental in Satellite Launch – A satellite, designed and built by teams from Kirtland Air Force Base and SS&TP company ATA Aerospace, was recently launched from the Cape Canaveral Air Force Station in Florida. The satellite features a sensor that can evaluate techniques for detecting and tracking objects in space. While the operation is being managed by the Air Force Research Laboratory's Space Vehicles Directorate, ATA Aerospace was the project's integration and test contractor.
